Elevator speech

- Builds on design heritage and success of Aeron, Mirra, Celle.
- 'Embodies' all we've learned about seating to date, and more.
- Designed by Bill Stumpf and Jeff Weber.
- First chair to support body and mind.

Design concepts

- Movement Body and mind work best when in motion.
 To promote healthful sitting, a chair must help us move as the body was intended to move.
- Zoned support Matrix of pixels in seat and back create dynamic surface that adjusts to contours of user.
 Supports different zones of body as needed.
- Working recline Embody encourages this posture as most healthy for computer users. Alleviates compression that normally forms on spine and pelvis when sitting upright.

Comfort

Thermal comfort

- Textile is breathable.
- Flexible polymer material & open structure allow air flow.

Pressure distribution

- Pixelated support: 'pocket sprung' seat, instinctive back.
- Frameless back & seat doesn't impede blood flow.

Support

Supporting the spine

- Pelvis stabilised in natural forward position.
- Backfit™ sacral, lumbar and thoracic support.

Supporting movement

- Frameless, narrow back
- H-flexors
- Embody tilt



Diversity

Accommodates 2nd to 98th percentile of population. Demonstrate chair adjustments – adjust chair to fit user.

- 1 Lower gas lift to bottom to release pressure from seat front; use tip-toes if necessary.
- 2 Adjust seat depth (381 457mm): 4-finger gap between calf and seat front.
- 3 Move gas lift up (431 559mm) to correct sitting level: 90° angle calf to thigh.
- 4 Rotate tension control to sitter's comfort level.
- 5 Move arms up/down/in/out to support sitter's arms (arm height 165 292mm; width 304 533mm).
- 6 Lock backrest.
- 7 Rotate Backfit[™] all the way forward.
- 8 Rotate back until sitter is at postural equilibrium (head and pelvis vertically aligned).
- 9 Experience kicker while seat is locked; 10° of flex.
- 10 Release tilt limiter and allow sitter to rock.

- 12 year warranty
- 3 years on fabric
- 3 years on gas lift

- Design for the Environment (DfE)
- McDonough Braungart Design Chemistry (MBDC) Cradle-to-cradle certification, Silver
- 95% recyclable
- 42% recycled content
- No PVCs

- 6 colours in Balance fabric
- 10 colours in Rhythm fabric
- Frame is graphite or white
- Base is Graphite, Titanium or Polished aluminium
